The slate is published for a minimum of two weeks before the election which takes place at the first meeting in May. Officers take office for one year except the trustees who are elected for the term of three years.

Then at the meeting when the election takes place we call for any nominations from the floor. As I think this is done at both the nominations presentation and at the election, but I AM NOT SURE, I will be asking members present about that. Otherwise I will do a call for any further nominations at both meetings, April and May.
