F.N Report: Thanks to all who came to the May meeting, we decided to skip a June meeting as several of the regular attendees would be going to the Catholic Schools Fund Raiser the night of the June meeting, and therefore we also decided to just do an eblast for June, sorry to the 23 members that do not have email, they were not mailed anything in June. For July we are planning on meeting at Council 574's clubroom, for dinner and swearing in the officers for next year. The Master; Marce Tebbe is to come if possible to do the swearing in.

Comptroller's Report; Bob reported that 36 members are Honorary and no longer have to pay dues, 4 are Honorary Life and pay a reduced rate, although some of these members will make donations. That we have 10 mbrs that are delinquent and hopefully they will get caught up, that is 8 members who owe for this year at \$25 and one who owes for two years, \$50 and one who owes \$90. They were contacted again.

Purser / Treasuer's Report; As of May 31st the bank balances are;

Total Checking Cash balance of \$2,323.34; that the Assembly Regular Fund Balance is \$1,375.09 the Chalice cking accnt bal is; \$948.25. We have a CD at \$5000 that Matures in June of 2017 and \$2571.32 in the Money Market, after moving \$3000 to the Ave Maria Fund after our April meeting. We learned that at this lower Money Market balance, they were charging us a \$15 monthly fee, so we moved the balance to the Ave Maria Funds, we can readily access this money so we have even better fluidity of our funds. The motion was by Mike and 2nd by Dan Kraft. We discussed what to do with the CD when it matures and after discussion it was decided to invest it in the Ave Maria Dividend Fund. There was a motion and a second and it passed. Bill for \$29.41 was presented, Dave motioned, Mike 2nd it, to pay the bill. It passed. Also see the NEW Business section.

Captain's Report: Alan reminded us of the upcoming Honor Guards and that none were scheduled beyond the Illinois Special Olympics Opening Ceremony on Friday June 9th. But that The Bishops Mass is coming up in the near future and Fr Greg Nelson would like us to provide an Honor Guard. for St. Mary's Sesquicentenial, info to come on both of these. We did receive a date for the Sesquicentennial, It is scheduled for a mass at 10 AM on Sunday, Sept 3rd, and Bishop Jenky will be attending. Also, we will probably be invited to appear as an Honor Guard for the Sheridan School Parade, probably Sept 1st.

Communications: The Master sent his newsletter, and the Knightline news, were both discussed.

The slate was approved.

New Business; A motion was made not to have a June meeting, and that the July meeting be at 574 clubroom and to supply the meat for the meal with everyone to bring a covered dish to share. Motion by by Mike and 2nd by Dan, motion passed.
