Fr Neri Greskoviak, OFM, embraced Sister Death on August 15, 2021, after experiencing several falls and declining health due to his ongoing struggle with cancer. Born on March 23, 1936, in Minonk, IL Richard entered the Priesthood on August 15, 1954, and received the religious name "Neri." In 1977 Neri served here as Associate Pastor at St. Mary Parish for 3 years. Neri retired from full time ministry in 2014 and moved to the St. Mary Friary in Bloomington. At St. Mary, while semi-retired, Neri served as Parochial Vicar. Born and entered the Priesthood on the Feast of the Assumption of Blessed Virgin Mary, may he rest in peace.


